NARRATIVE REPORT (FROM JANUARY - DECEMBER 2017)

The year 2017 was a fruitful one as in the project area with the assistance of SKN we focused on the children with disability, pwds and this has brought in some changes in their life. Vikas Deepti with the help of the staff, cwds, pwds, parents/guardians etc were instrumental in bringing changes in their life and their living condition. The following activities and changes were seen.

Some Significant Achievements/Results:

Relevance of Action - 1: Health awareness camp for pregnant women (prevention):



The targets of good health certainly are the women and we had programmes for the pregnant women and the focus was prevention of disability. There were 402 participants in the health awareness camps. ANM, Ashakarmis, and Anganwadi teachers gave talks specially on the delivery care and post-natal care, immunization personal health care, and prevention of disability. Nutrition and causes of disability were also discussed.

The Achievements

- ❖ 10 health camps have been organized for pregnant women..
- ❖ 402 women from 10 villages participated in the health camps.

Change

The percentage of percentage of infant mortality rate (IMR) mother mortality rate (MMR) has come down in the villages. They got opportunity for getting themselves some awareness and health inputs. The pregnant women are aware of the root causes of disabilities & benefits of hospital delivery.

Relevance of Action - 2: Health Awareness Camp for Adolescent Girls:

Health awareness camps give real education for the persons with whom we are connected. We had conducted awareness camps in 10 Gram panchayats in 4 blocks of Bargarh district that covered topics like nutrition, immunization, anemia, early marriage and health education. The participants were about 450 Adolescent girls. The resource person like ANM, Anganwadi, Ashakarmi gave talks on the safety of adolescent girls, regular health check up using of iron tablet, Folic acids, Albondazal tablets etc. They talked on the causes of disability, govt. facilities. Various health issues and issue of early marriage too was discussed.



The Achievements

- ❖ 10 health awareness camps were organized in 4 Blocks.
- ❖ IEC materials distributed in the health awareness camps.
- ❖ 450 adolescent girls were sensitized on nutrition, immunization, early marriage and regular health check up.
- ❖ 265 adolescent girls got free medicines like: iron tablet, Albondazal tablet, and Chhatua etc.

Change

- The adolescent girls are aware of the issues of health and marriage related concerns specially early marriage and the effects of it. They know the importance of attending the "Mamata Dibas" and keeping good contact with ANM and AWC teachers in the project.

Relevance of Action - 3: Training Camp for CP and MR children:



There is need for taking care for the CP & MR children more and more as their number is growing. Hence along with their parents and guardians we train and teach specially physiotherapy and ADL and assess the children in the above mentioned camps. They were held at Barpali, Gaislet, Attabira, & Bijepur blocks. There were 247 participants took part in the training. The parents/guardians of the CWDs attended the 4 days training in their own areas and became aware of the benefits of regular exercises and ADL trainings along with the use of aids and appliances. During the camp the parents/guardians are helped with our assistance to manage the children in their set up. The

physiotherapist and CBR workers do the follow up of the same in the field along with the coordinator. The parents/guardians are also given awareness on government facilities like: handicapped certificate, bus pass, train pass, monthly pension, and scholarship, on line apply etc.

The Achievement

- ❖ 247 CP and MR children participated in the camps and got sensitized about the regular exercise and ADL Trainings.
- ❖ 180 CWDs are getting regular physiotherapy and ADL trainings by the family members due to the camps
- ❖ 262 CWDs have got linkage for pension, scholarship online handicapped certificate, PDR rice against Rs 200/- and Aids and appliances from the government.

Change

- Now to some extent the CP and MR children are able to sit, move and stand on their own, some of them are eating, bathing, brushing and combing on their own and some with bit of help. The family members of the CWDs are giving regular physiotherapy and ADL training to their children. They go to the special schools and formal schools without much force and we can see some changes in them.

Relevance of Action - 4: Speech therapy training for CWDs:

There are many children who need help for their speech and hence speech therapy training for the hearing impaired (HI) and speech impaired (SI) CWDs and their parents was held at Bargarh, Bijepur, & Barpali blocks. 144 members attended the training which had also practical session with the causes of hearing loss, speech problem, identification, hearing, sign language etc. The follow up in the field areas was also dealt with.



The Achievement

- ❖ 144 CWDs and parents attended the speech therapy training at Vikas Deepti.
- ❖ 176 speech and hearing loss children were identified in the field and 21 CWDs got linkage in hearing aids through district administration.
- ❖ 20 CWDs got admission in special schools and formal schools in the project area.

Change

- *The parents, CBR workers, teachers and Network members have developed the knowledge of sign language and how to assess hearing loss and speech problem cases. Now they are capable of identifying such cases in the field and motivate children's parents for linkage of government facilities and education in the field. Most of the families are regular doing the speech therapy towards their children.*

Relevance of Action - 5: Community sensitization on Health, Education & schemes:



CWDs and PWDs got an opportunity for health awareness because of the camps held in 10 villages in Bargarh district. There were 388 participants in our four blocks for the health education camp. ANM, ASHA, AWC teams were in the program. All the CWDs/PWDs got the awareness about health & govt. schemes. Parents became aware about the diabetics and eye defects of their children. ANM advised about the prevention of low vision, anemia and high blood pressure. They also discussed about the food and nutrition, water and sanitation.

The Achievements

- ❖ *388 CWDs and parents attended the health awareness camps in four blocks.*
- ❖ *380 CWDs got the IEC materials.*
- ❖ *140 CWDs got the iron tablets on the same day.*

Change

- *Due to the awareness created in the camps the parents became aware about the different causes of diseases. Now they have started motivation to their children in their villages. Parents/guardians provide the nutritious foods to their children and keep regular contact with ANM and nearest hospitals. Govt. linkage has become better.*

Relevance of Action - 6: Six monthly meeting with parents of CWDs at Special school:

The meeting of CWDs parents/special school teachers was the new initiative taken. It was held at seven special schools. It dealt with the topic of how to teach the MR, CP and low vision children. They are equipped with the use of teaching materials and skills. All the special schools are following the same method of teaching to the CWDs. Most of the items are practically shown to the children and they are able to identify the



pictures with real life events during the class. The children are also able to identify these pictures in their books. They are able to identify the different flowers, fruits, birds, animals and other assets in their homes. Parents too follow it up in their houses.

The Achievements

- ❖ 260 parents/teachers took part in the fourteen meetings and became aware about the methods.
- ❖ 7 schools have done six month review meetings regularly.

Change

- The parents of special schools teachers and CBR workers have developed teaching skills and are helping the children in their school.
- They have developed different teaching aids in their special schools and using it for their studies.

Relevance of Action -7: Awareness on child rights for children:



We had organized child rights meeting in 10 villages under four blocks. There were 345 participants. We had taken into discussion topics like: who is a child? What are child rights? What are the main child issues in the block? All the participants discussed and shared the major points like Right to protection, Right to survival, Right to development, Right to participation etc. Awareness was also raised on developing the capacity to analyze, understand and influence the child rights for advancing issues of child care, protection and child education.

The Achievements

- ❖ 345 participants from four blocks under 10 villages attended the child rights meeting.
- ❖ 6 issues were identified and plan was made to have linkage with govt department.

Change

They became aware of the child rights and they highlighted the CWDs issues in the Pallasabha and Gramsabha. All have agreed to mainstream the children for education and stop the child labor. There is agreement to stop the early marriage in our five blocks.

Relevance of Action - 8: Block level Cultural performance for CWDs:

In order to improve and create platform for bringing out their talents block level Cultural performance for CWDs was held at Barpali and Bijepur block. 484 members attended the program ABDO; Chairman, were the chief guests. The Sarpanches, Anganwadi teachers, Ashakarmis, network members, CWDs parents participated in the program. The children performed in different dances & got awarded with prizes and certificates on the day.



The Achievements

- ❖ 484 participants from 103 villages under Bijepur and Barpali block participated in the program.

Change

- Due to the above opportunity the confidence of the children has got a boost and we hope that they will participate better in the future. Their parents /guardians are also very happy and other CWDs in the closer by areas also try to take part in the different events.

Relevance of Action – 9: Resource mobilization training for network members:



The network members play a very important role and in order to build their skill Resource mobilization training was held at Ugresan Bhwan Barpali Janasakti Virna khyam Sangathan. There were 27 members attended the above training. Mr. Amit kumar Khamari, resource person from New Delhi was the trainer. To certain extent they are now able to collect the membership. Efforts are made now to have Local resources and other resources. Manpower, money, infrastructure, SHG product safe, local donors are slowly identified and network members are strengthened. MP and MLA funds are also mobilized to sustain their activities. This is also helping them to improve and manage the activities in the future. They have also improved their membership collection.

The Achievement

- ❖ 27 network members from Barpali have collected their membership of Rs 22860/- and deposited in their network accounts.
- ❖ They have managed to have one office room at the existing market place at Barpali.

Change:

➤ Due to the resource mobilization training all the network members are aware about the local fund, resource collection. They contact the different donors and mobilize the resources from community and government departments and try other donors too.

Relevance of Action - 10: Essay Competition for High School Students:



The young minds are the best to impart the necessary instructions. Essay competition for High School Students was organized in our three Blocks under 15 High Schools on disability issues. We are glad that 449 students took part in Essay competition. This effort has brought in motivation in the children to be aware of the issues. The best three Essays were awarded with prizes and certificates. The students/teachers were very happy and co-operative with us and thus help the children to be aware of the need to have awareness on prevention of disability.

The Achievements

- ❖ 449 High school students participated in the competition and became aware of the causes of disability and prevention of disabilities.
- ❖ 45 children got prizes and certificates.

Change

High school students will become the agents of creating awareness in nearby areas and thus will help us and the society to build a better society. The parents and teachers welcome us for such programmes as they become handy for the children to build better lives.

11: Wall painting on prevention of disability & Child Rights:

In order to create mass awareness about prevention of disabilities and protection of pregnant women, we have done wall paintings with photographs in our project area like-Bijepur, Barpali & Attabira in 20 villages. Twenty wall paintings with Messages and pictures are available for their knowledge and practical life. The pregnant women from that area have got awareness through the wall paintings and it will help them immensely. It will have more impact with pregnant women as they can claim their rights for government facilities. Now their family members are also aware about taking care of pregnant women. Ashakarmi, Anganwadi, & ANM regularly visit with their staff and talk on prevention of disability.

The Achievements

- ❖ 20 wall paintings are done at three blocks and mass awareness is created about prevention of disability to general public in the operational area.
- ❖ Rural women have access to these pictures and go for their health checkup and nutrition foods.

Change

At community level ANM, Asha and Anganwadis are helping pregnant women and have their names in AWC centers. They are also motivating on immunization and prevention of disability. Early marriage is stopping in the project area and their parents are sensitized about the causes of disability.

12. Special education for CP and MR children:



Education can bring changes in the persons and we prepare the cerebral palsy and mentally retarded children for the formal schools in our four blocks. 107 CP and MR children are regularly attending the special schools. Through our regular motivation to parents now their parents send their children to the special schools on a regular basis. They follow the method of Joyful learning, TLM, to teach the children. Besides learning they are also given physiotherapy and ADL training in the schools.

We have seven village education committees (VEC) in these special schools. The VEC is monitoring the special schools, motivating the parents to send the children regularly. They monitor the day to day functioning of the school like checking the distribution of the nutrition, study material and government facilities. VEC members, teachers, parents and Aganwadi workers jointly celebrate the Republic day, Independence day and children's day at all special schools and organize the different events for the CWDs. At present CP and MR children are taking part in different curricular activities and some of them are enrolled in the formal schools. Here are some details;

The Achievement

- ❖ *107 CP and OH children attend the special school regularly in our seven schools.*
- ❖ *21 CWDs are enrolled in the formal schools.*
- ❖ *Rs 43007/-- children fund is created in our seven special schools towards future management.*
- ❖ *42 CWDs got the scholarship support of Rs,105000/- from S.S.A.*

Change

- *CP and MR children are getting opportunities for their education and now the parents/guardians take special effort to send them to schooling.*
- *The formal school is ready to accept our children and encourage the educational effort of our children. This would bring in change in the society.*

Relevance of Action -13: District level Child Fair:



On the occasion of the children day celebration a district level child fair was organized on 14th Nov-2017 at Gurumarket Bargarh. Mr. Ambujakhyar Padhan DSSO Bargarh was the chief guest. The NGOs, school teachers, CBOs and CWDs and PWDs are participated in the child fare. There were 380 children from our five blocks attended the program. The chief guest assured his support to CWDs and Vikas Deepti. The cultural program by the disabled children was wonderfully appreciated. He distributed prizes to the winners of song competition, dance competition, music competition, drawing competition and chocolate race and various games conducted. It was great encouragement to all the children and their parents.

The Achievements

- ❖ *380 CWDs and their parents participated in the fair at Satsangbihar, Bargarh from five blocks.*
- ❖ *80 CWDs received prizes in different events in the program.*
- ❖ *The participants were from 270 villages, special schools, children etc.*

Change

- *The children have built in confidence to come forward and compete in various activities without hesitation.*
- *The parents/villagers have also have a change in their attitude towards CWDs and know that they can do something like others.*

Relevance of Action - 14: The world disability day celebration:

World Disability day was held on 12-12.2017 at Laderpali in Attabira Block and Barpali block. There were 670 CWDs/PWDs for the program from 122 villages in our two blocks. The chief guest was Mr. Lakhyapati Behera ABDO, Smt.Sabita Bag NAC chairman was the chief guist on this ocession. Sarpanch, NGOs, Network members were present for the program.



We had organized a general meeting and different events like: ball throw, chocolate race, musica chair, pot breaking, colour identification, song competition, dance competition etc. The participants were divided into two groups (junior & senior). The winners were given prizes in order to encourage them. The chief guest appreciated for having conducted such a program for the physically challenged children in that area and expressed his support. The parents and guardians of the CWDs were quite co-operative and were very happy to attend such a program for their children and for the first time in their village.

The network members, CBR workers and co-ordinators played a vital role in conducting the program. The village leaders, SHG members, club members had extended their support for the success of this program.

The Achievements

- ❖ *670 CWDs/PWDs attended the world disability day celebration from 122 villages under two blocks.*
- ❖ *86 CWDs got prizes in the events conducted as above.*
- ❖ *Govt-officials, NGO, CBOs, Network members actively participated in the program.*
- ❖ *33 cultural programs were performed that created awareness to other CWDs in that area.*

Change

- *The network committee members managed to organize the world disability day in their blocks taking lead. The CWDs/PWDs have started taking active role in the programmes conducted. The participation has improved which is encouraging.*

Relevance of Action - 15: Networking of PWDs:

The network members are the future of our involvements. They have good relationship with each other and this time they organized a quarterly review meeting in our five blocks through their executive body. AJVS Bheden, Pragati Network Bargarh, the oldest networks independently organized the review meetings and worked out their common action plan. They are also monitoring the existing activities in their area and follow up of the activities every month and submit the report to Vikas Deepti.



Three new networks like: Janasakti, Barpali, Netaji network at Attabira and Jagruti network at Bijepur block slowly have started the issues addressing and linkage with the govt facilities to the CWDs/PWDs in their operational area. Community leaders, SHG members and network members take responsibility towards activities, follow up and mobilize the local resources. They are able to motivate the PWDs/CWDs and their parents about PWD rights and mobilize different govt facilities and schemes for the benefits of the CWDs and PWDs in the project area.

The Achievement

- ❖ *The five networks under five blocks like: Bheden, Bargarh, Attabira, Bijepur and Barpali have 3625 PWDs who have paid members contribution to the network.*
- ❖ *Rs 1,57,000/- (one lakh fifty seven thousand) membership is collected for their future management.*
- ❖ *One network at Bheden is registered under 1860 Act and mobilize the funds from govt.*
- ❖ *Two networks are member with state level disability forum in odisha.*

Change

- *We can see that the network members have been able to build up a good rapport with the government departments, PRI leaders, NGOs, CBOS in the district. To some extent they are able to take up the responsibilities in mobilizing the local resources and motivate the PWDs.*
- *Time to time they contact with government officials and mobilize the different govt schemes. Network committee has put on their efforts to mobilize monthly pension, aids and appliances in their blocks.*

Relevance of Action: 16: Supply of Aids and appliances for CWDs/PWDs.-2017:



Aids & appliances play a great role for mobility. Through our Orthotic and prosthetic workshop we have provided different types of aids and appliances to the CWDs, who were in need of it. In 2017 we have provided 46 appliances with SKN project support. With this their mobility has improved and they are able to go to different places like: Schools,



offices, markets, towns and Grampanchayats on their own. They are able to take part in the programs.

The Achievements

- ❖ 46 CWDs/PWDs are using their different aids and appliances supported from SKN project.2017.
- ❖ 107 CWDs attend the schools, market places, banks and panchayats by the help of appliances.
- ❖ 13 CWDs have received the village level adoption care through this support.

Change

- The CWDs/PWDs of the project area have got access to different types of aids and appliances from Vikas Deepti and use it regularly.
- Now their depending for mobility is reduced and they also attend the different festivals and occasions in their village.
- At present CWDs parents/guardians are very happy of the development of their children.
- Children are able to attend schools regularly.

Relevance of Action -17: Skill building training for young PWDs:

The PWDs when supported in their trades of income show a tremendous interest in life. Hence their training in tailoring, mehendi design, cotton bati making and paper bag making have brought economic support and a new life has been made possible. Since they are able to earn for their sustenance it brings encouragement towards their independence. Given more stress on their earning and learning they would become bread winners in their families.



The Achievements

- ❖ 83 young PWDs boys and girls have completed the vocational training in different trades in our four blocks.
- ❖ 12 PWDs have started their business in their villages and they are able to earn Rs 1200/- to Rs 3000/- per month through different vocational activities.
- ❖ 6 PWD girls have created their assets like sewing machines and continue the business in their homes.

Change

- *Due to the vocational trainings our PwDs are self employed in their villages and earn regularly.*
- *Some of have created home assets like: mobile handset, wristwatch, T.V etc.*
- *Now their living condition has improved. They are able to live with other in the society.*
- *Since they have become earning members of their families and they are gained self respect in their communities and their dependency in the family has reduced.*

Relevance of Action - 18: Legal aid training for network members:



On 28.11.2017 - 29.11.2017 we had organized Legal aid training for network members. 26 members participated in the Legal aid training. The participants were informed of various laws, legal provisions etc for their future involvements. They got inputs on PWD rights /issues & different schemes that are available at district levels. It will help them to go ahead confidently about obtaining their rights. We are confident that thought not immediately but in the long run it will give them opportunity to work better.

The achievements

- ❖ 26 participants from three networks attended the legal aid training at AIESS office Bargarh.
- ❖ 16 issues we had identified and discussed about for future action.

- The Network members CBR workers are aware of the legal laws & rights. Now they are helping CWDs/PWDs to solve the issue & facilities in the field area.
- District legal aid cell also helping the PWDs in their day to day issues.

Relevance of Action - 19: Self employment of PWDs:



Income Generation Activities (IGP) have changed the lives of the disabled. In our project area 273 new young PWDs have got self employment through the different income generation activities in our field area. They were trained in different vocational trade like: mobile repair, tailoring, cotton bati making, cycle repair, screen printing, Dish TV repair, electronics, Art and painting, paper bag making, kiranashop management, leaf plate making, tea stall etc.

Young PWD have got individual loans through bank and Vikas Deepti Rs 3,56,000/- (three lakh fifty six thousand only) from bank and organization. This indeed is encouraging as it leads them towards self employment and PWDs are earning every month Rs 3000/- and thus manage their families financially. Now their business and marketing idea has developed and they are interested to collect more resources for their living from small micro-entrepreneurship activities.

The Achievements

Change

- The young PWDs are self employed in their village and earn their livelihood and supporting their families.
- Now family members are very happy and helping towards marketing and their product sale.
- Some of them have created home assets, having regular saving accounts.
- Now their dependence in the family has reduced and PWDs have gained self respect in the society.

Relevance of Action - 20: Govt facilities obtained:

Through various interventions we have helped the persons with disability to avail government facilities. The awareness through the project intervention for our children and their parents to come forward in order to obtain the different govt facilities like: handicapped certificate, bus pass, train pass, ID card, monthly pension, scholarship, IAY house, individual loan, aids and appliances etc has done a better life to them.



Since the government officials are sensitized through our program, they now help the CWDs/PWDs, parents in our neighboring blocks. Network members, NGOs, CBO, and govt officials have developed good relationship in the block level and district level. Through the district social security officer (DSSO), CWDs are getting wheel chairs, hearing aids, crutches, scholarship, and DRI loans. The person with 60% and 100% disability have got Rs 500/- monthly pension in the district

The Achievements

- ❖ 5 network committee members have attended the every month medical board camp at CDMO office.
- ❖ 842 CWDs/PWDs have got the Rs 500/- monthly pension in our five blocks.
- ❖ 07 PWDs are got linkage in Indira Abhas House and got the financial support of Rs 8,75,000/- (Eight lakh seventy five thousand only) from government.
- ❖ CWDs/PWDs got the different Aids and appliances from district administration.

Change

- ❖ *The government officers are aware of the need of CWDs/PWDs and co-operate with children in all blocks and district level.*
- ❖ *CBR workers, network members, NGOs, CBOs meet the concerned government authorities for their linkage.*
- ❖ *They are able to go to different offices, markets, banks, schools by their own, some of the burden has reduces in their families.*

Relevance of action 21 – Self Help Groups (SHG):

In our project area young PWDs have formed Self Help Groups (SHG). At present 125 SHGs are formed under five Blocks of Bargarh, Bheden, Barpali, Attabira & Bijepur. These SHGs are regularly doing their monthly meetings and depositing their savings in all groups. All members are paying monthly membership and now they have a savings of Rs.26,63,000/-at different banks in 2017. All in all 703 members had attended the regular meetings and are managing their records. Now they have started business like-: weaving, leaf plate making, tailoring, small hotel, grocery etc.

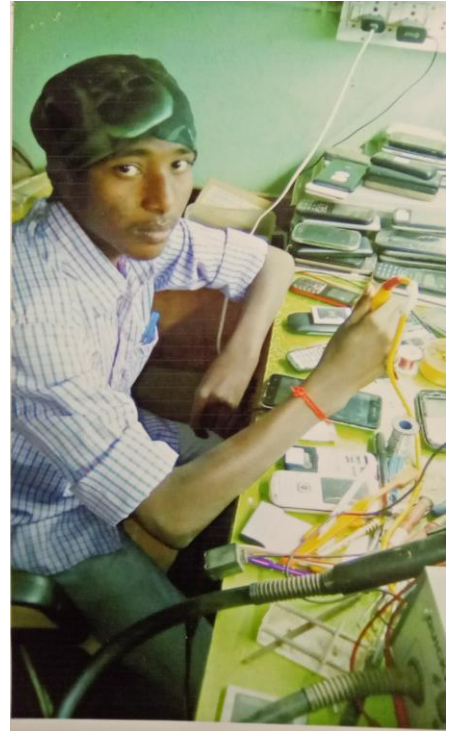

1. Case study: I stand on my own:

I am Himanshu Meher, son of Mr. Ramprasad Meher from Karmunda village under Bijepur Block district, Bargarh. I am nineteen year old and my physical deformity is 60 % cerebral palsy. Our family has five members. My father is a weaver. My mother says that she was unaware of nutritious foods and immunization. She said that during this time she was unconscious during delivery and could not even listen to my cry.

After few years gone CBR worker Miss Nilima Paik came to my house and collected the birth history and explained the benefit of having physiotherapy to my parents.

Later she discussed regarding the vocational training and the effect of it in my life. My father agreed to send me for the skill building training on mobile repair at Bijepur. I regularly attended the three months training on mobile repair and got the Certificate and applied for the loan from Vikas Deepti. Few months gone I got the financial support of Rs.10.000/- and started the mobile repair shop at home Now my business is going on well and I am able to earn a monthly income of Rs.3000/-to Rs.4000/-. My family is glad that I went ahead in this line. Today my parents and me are grateful to Vikas Deepti and the CBR worker and staff.





2. Case study : Self confidence change the life.

I am Chudamani Bagarti son of Prasan Bagarti from Kumbhari village under Barpali block, district Bargarh. My village is 7 K.M far from Barpali. Our family had four members and we belong to a very poor family. My physical deformity is 50% cerebral palsy. I am eight years old. I was spending most of my time in my home. One day CBR worker Miss. Tikifula Nag came to my home and discussed with my mother about my birth history. My mother says that she was unaware of immunization and regular consultation of doctor when she was carrying me. She was unconscious during the delivery and couldn't even listen to the cry of mine.

After three years passed, the CBR worker started the exercises weekly two times and slowly I was could stand with support. Today caliper is provided and now I am using it and moving by myself. Now without the help of others I am able to move to other places. I do go to formal schools regularly and now am in 2nd standard. I feel happy and the progress has taken in me is amomnt of happiness to my family and me. I and my parents are grateful to Vikas Deepti and the CBR workers for their constant visit and accompaniment in my life.
